The Quiz: The answers are all names of music acts that have topped the UK singles chart. Clues are straight or cryptic with a few **anagrams in bold**. Each clue includes a letter count for the words in the answer (ignoring all punctuation). Use all three elements: the clue, the letter count and the theme to work out the answers. The majority of acts will be known to those who grew up watching *Top of the Pops*, however, if you get stuck and need "inspiration" have a look at *Wikipedia* or books published by *Guinness World Records*.
